5alk Oklahoma won its sixth NCAA Championship after taking both games over Texas in the Women's College World Series Finals. The Sooners have won four of the last six championships staged.
"11 It was the first time a league has had both teams in the title matchup since 2014.
Wif OU had 41 run-rule victories, 33 shutouts, eight no-hitters, held opponents to one run or fewer 49 times and hit home runs in 56 of 62 games this season.

2nd1 UT's runner-up finish was the best in program history. The Longhorns became the first unseeded team to reach the finals of the WCWS.

T11 Texas freshman third baseman Mia Scott finished her WCWS as the Longhorn's alltime hit header in the event with IO.

Ta115 Oklahoma State reached the semifinals at the WCWS in the program's thirdconsecutive trip to Oklahoma City. Since the Super Regionals were added to the NCAA postseason in 2005, this year was the first time in OSU history that the Cowgirls reached the WCWS undefeated in postseason play.

Tal Kelly Maxwell became the third Cowgirl in program history to total 300 or more strikeouts in a single season (313) as she joined Cowgirl Olympians Lauren Bay and Melanie Roche.

Tar1 This year is the first time since 2015 that a conference has placed three teams into the semifinals and is the most Big 12 teams to make the final four in a single year at the WCWS.
T.115 The Big 12 advanced a nation-high 42.9 percent of its teams to the WCWS and tied for first among conferences with the number of teams to make it to Oklahoma City. It is the highest percentage of teams the Conference has ever placed into the WCWS.

Tilf The three teams in the WCWS are the most for the league since 2011 when four teams qualified.

Tat1 Oklahoma's Jocelyn Alo was named the Most Outstanding Player of the WCWS and was joined by teammates Rylie Boone, Jayda Coleman, Tiare Jennings and Hope Trautwein on the All-Tournament Team. OSU's Maxwell made the team along with Texas' Estelle Czech, Courtney Day and Bella Dayton. The Big 12 had nine of the I2 selections on the team.

5at1 Baylor won the National Invitational Softball Championship defeating UNLV 4-0 in the Championship Final. Aliyah Binford tossed a complete-game two-hitter with nine strikeouts to help secure BU's fourth straight win in the tournament. McKenzie Wilson, Ana Watson and Kaci West were named to the All-Tournament Team.

5ar Kansas finished with a 4-2 run to finish in third place at the NISC. Olivia Bruno and Savanna DesRochers were named to the All-Tournament Team.

2 2at1 Alo became the first player in history to hit 30 home runs and bat .500 in the same season finishing with 34 home runs, a .515 average, . 646 on-base percentage and a 1.212 slugging percentage, tying her home run record from 2021 and marking Big 2 records for the other three. She was named the Honda Sport Award winner for softball.
2011 Nine Big 12 players were named to the 2022 NFCA DI All-American team. The full listing can be found on the next page.
5.11 Oklahoma State won its first-ever Big 12 Softball title after defeating the Sooners $4-3$ in eight innings at the Phillips 66 Big 12 Softtball Championship. OSU's Morgan Day was named the Most Outstanding Player of the Championship.
The Championship Final featured a record crowd of 5,410 fans while the entire event totaled 12,433 over three days, a record for the Bigl2 Softball Championship.
却11 Oklahoma won its IOth straight Big 12 regular-season title and 14th overall.
5a11 The Sooners collected five All-Big 12 individual awards which included Alo winning Player of the Year for the second season in a row, Bahl earning Pitcher of the Year (Co) and Freshman of the Year while Grace Lyons repeated as Defensive Player of the Year and Patty Gasso was named Coach of the Year for an unprecedented IOth year in a row and 14th overall time.
5:11 OSU's Maxwell was also tabbed Co-Pitcher of the Year.
$5 \times 1 \zeta$ Oklahoma led First Team All-Big 12 selections with six players while Oklahoma State led Second Team honorees with four. Texas has the most players on the All-Freshman Team with three Longhorns listed. Awards were voted on by the league's head coaches and the All-Big 12 First Team can be found on page three of this release.

541k Iowa State finished with a 28-27 overall record, marking the first time since 19881989 that lowa State has posted back-to-back winning seasons.
