DOWN THE STRAITAWAY WITH THE BIG 12

OFF TO THE FINAL RACE: The Big 12 track and field teams will finish off the 2004 season at the NCAA Track and Field Championship in Austin, Texas.... Texas will serve as the host institution for the event for the first time in the Mike A. Myers Stadium.... The event is from Wednesday - Saturday.

A total of 90 Big 12 student athletes will represent the league at this year's national meet, with Texas, Texas A&M and Texas Tech having the most athletes competing.... The number of attendees representing the league beats last season's number of 60 who traveled to California.... Another Big 12 note, this is also the first time since 2003, that the conference will have two schools enter as regional champions into track and field's last dance.... The Longhorns will have nine competing on the women's side and six for the men for a total of 15 attending.... The Aggies will bring in 13 student-athletes with eight competing in throwing events, and Tech will stroll in with 11 competitors.

BAYLOR

The Bears will send 10 individuals and four relay squads to the NCAA Outdoor Track & Field Championships.... Sophomore Jeremy Wariner, the NCAA indoor champion, and junior Darold Williamson rank 1-2 in the country in the 400 meters at 44.50 and 44.51 seconds, respectively.... The pair also currently ranks 2-3 in the world.... Wariner and Williamson also lead the 4x400 relay team which is undefeated this year, including the indoor title.... Junior April Holliness, a three-time All-American, took gold at the NCAA Midwest Regional in the long jump by shattering her school record with a leap of 21-10 1/4.... Senior Jordan Willmann finished fifth in the heptathlon last year to earn All-American honors.

COLORADO

2003 NCAA Midwest Regional champion Natalie Florence capped off a season best in the steeplechase in the final day of the NCAA Midwest Regional Track and Field Championships in College Station, Texas.... Florence placed third in the event with a 10-minute, 42.35 second time.... Discus thrower Zach Hazen placed second with a personal record throw of 174-6 in the preliminary round of the event, assisting the Buffalo men's squad to a 19th place finish.... Long distance runner Dathan Ritzenhein won the NCAA Midwest Regional Outdoor 5,000-meter title in a season best 14 minutes, 04.75 seconds at the Anderson Track and Field Complex last Friday night while Renee Metivier finished fourth in the day's only other final, the women's 5k, in 17:06.62.

IOWA STATE

The Cyclones ended competition at the NCAA Regional meet with five athletes and a 4x400-relay team finishing in the top nine.... On the field for the men, thrower Jamal Salahuddin finished ninth in the men's discus with a toss of 190-2, a career best for the junior.... In the javelin, Matt Murdock took a fifth-place win with a

throw of 211-8. In the triple jump for ISU was senior Daniel Kaczmarczyk for ninth place with a leap of 50-4 1/2.... The men's 4x400-relay team garnered a sixth-place win with a group clocking of 3:10.79.... The team consisted of Jerod Torrey, Elijah Braimah, Ryan Boyington, and Jared Graham.... Ada Anderson took eighth in the women's 800-meter run with a final time of 2:10.57.... Freshman leaper Agata Kosuda took fifth place in the regional triple jump competition with a leap of 42 feet.

KANSAS

Senior Laura Lavoie and junior Brooklyn Hann will join sophomore Benson Chesang in representing the KU at the NCAA Outdoor Championships on June 9-12 in Austin, Texas... Lavoie finished fourth in the 1500-meter run at the Midwest Regional Championships with a time of 4:29.44, while Hann posted a fourth place finish in the triple jump with a distance of 42-08.00... Chesang advanced to the Outdoor Championships on Friday after finishing second in the 5000-meter run with a time of 14:17.04... Freshman Gavin Ball finished 12th in the finals of the shot put with a throw of 57-0 1/4 and placed 24th in the discus with a throw of 170-11... Sophomore Charisse Bacchus finished eighth in the long jump with a distance of 20-8 1/2.

KANSAS STATE

Eight individuals qualified for the NCAA Outdoor Championships in Austin, Texas on June 9-12... The Wildcats had two individuals crowned champions at the Midwest Regionals in College Station, Texas, as Chaytan Hill won the women's triple jump and Kyle Lancaster captured the men's high jump title... Hill was particularly impressive in her win, as she recorded a near-NCAA record leap of 46-10.00... The mark, which would have set the NCAA, Big 12 and Kansas State record, was disqualified because it was over the wind-aided limitation of 2 mph... Lancaster posted the third-highest mark in school history in winning the high jump, as he tied his career-best height of 7-4 1/2 to claim 10 points for the men's squad... The mark, which he first posted at the 2003 Ward Haylett Invitational, also tied Charles Burney's mark at the 1998 U.S. National Championships... Lancaster, who has now eclipsed the seven foot barrier in seven of eight meets this season, returns to the NCAA Championships for second consecutive season after he garnered All-America honors by tying for fourth with a leap of 7-3 1/4... JaNelle Wright qualified automatically for the women's heptathlon with 5,615 points in finishing second at the Maynard Wildcat Combined Events on March 24... As a team, Kansas State repeated its third place finish of a year ago on the women's side at the Midwest Regional with 35.50 points, while the men's squad drastically improved their finish of year ago (30th out of 33 teams in 2003) by tying Colorado State for 11th-place with 25 points.

MISSOURI

Nine Tigers will compete at the NCAA Track and Field Championships in Austin, Texas, this week....Senior Janae Strickland who holds the Missouri record in the shot put will head to Austin on a hot streak after falling into a slump during the indoor season.... Strickland earned her first regional crown of her college career at the NCAA Mideast Regionals in Baton Rouge, La., May

29 setting a regional record throw of 55-1 1/2.... Sophomore Amanda Bales ran for a 20 second personal-best and fifth place finish at the Regional meet, clocking it at 16:26.71, the fourth-best time in Missouri.... For the men, Conrad Woolsey will compete at the national championship after placing fifth at the NCAA Midwest Regional.... Currently Woolsey ranks as the third-best thrower in Tiger history with a toss of 62-5 that was thrown at the Missouri Relays April 7, 2004.

NEBRASKA

The men's team was crowned NCAA Midwest Regional champions for the first time in the history of the second-year event, in College Station, Texas.... In extreme humidity and strong winds, the Huskers battled for the team title and came out on top by 18 points over defending regional champs Minnesota.... The women's team finished second to Texas in a team race that was even closer than the Big 12 Championships.... The Longhorns won the title with 110 points, followed by the Huskers' 105.... Carl Myerscough (shot put), Priscilla Lopes (100-meter hurdles), Becky Breisch (discus), Ann Gaffigan (3,000-meter steeplechase) and the stellar 4x100-meter relay team all claimed regional titles for the Huskers.... The men's 4x100-meter relay team recorded the second-fastest time in school history, getting the baton around the track in 39.62 seconds.... Gaffigan won the steeplechase by more than nine seconds, and Lopes put on a show in the 100-meter hurdles, crossing the line in 12.77, which would have been good for an NU school record, had it not been for the 5.1 tailwind.... Breisch extended her school record in the discus throw to 207-1, winning the event by more than 26 feet.

OKLAHOMA

The Sooners will have five representatives for the university at the 2004 NCAA Track and Field Championships this week.... Senior Laverne Jones who placed second in the 100 and 200 at the Midwest Regionals, will lead the way for OU.... She currently has the fifth best time in the country in the 100-meter dash and will only compete in that event.... Freshman Jessica Eldridge became the Midwest Regional champion in the 1500 May 29, with a time of 4:24.93... The win advanced her to the NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships in two weeks, her third NCAA meet to qualify for as a true freshman.... For the men, Sophomore DaBryan Blanton will not be competing at the NCAA championships.... Blanton was injured at the Big 12 Track and Field championships in the final stride of the 100-meter dash and was not able to compete at the regional meet, which will not allow him to compete at the national meet, according to NCAA rules.

OKLAHOMA STATE

Senior Jason Woolhouse finished third in the 5,000-m at this weekend's Midwest Regional Championships, earning himself a berth to the NCAA Championships with a time of 14:18.... For the women, the Cowgirls advanced three individuals on to the national meet.... Junior Valentina Medina qualified after placing second in the 1,500-meter run with a time of 4:26.17 while teammate Michelle Prowse bounced back from an illness that kept her out of the Big 12 championship to place fifth in the 5,000-meter run at the Midwest Regionals in College Station, Texas, May 29.... Delisa McClain will be the third girl to compete at the NCAA championships, earning one of the eight wild card positions to compete at the meet this week... McClain's best performance of the year that gained her a spot for the championships was measured at 197 feet.

TEXAS

The third-ranked women's track and field team captured its first NCAA Midwest Regional championship, in College Station with 110 points for a five-point victory over defending champion Nebraska.... The Longhorns automatically qualified nine athletes individually for the NCAA Championships, including freshman Marshevet Hooker in the 100m and long jump, and senior Raasin McIntosh in the 100- and 400-meter hurdles.... In addition, UT's 4x100m and 4x400m relays defended their regional titles to advance to the national meet.... The 14th-ranked men's track and field squad finished fourth with 56.25 points at the NCAA Mid-West Regional Championships behind titles from sophomore Brendan Christian in the 100m and senior Jermaine Cooper in the 110-meter hurdles.... Texas automatically qualified six athletes for the national meet at regionals with top-five finishes in their respective events.... Freshman Donovan Kilmartin automatically qualified for nationals in the decathlon with 7,729 points at the Texas Relays on April 1.... Christian broke Johnny "Lam" Jones' school

record, which he set in 1977, in the prelims in the 100m on Friday with a blistering 10.11 clocking.

TEXAS A&M

The Aggies will send a total of 13 athletes to the NCAA Track and Field Championships.... The maroon-and-white contingent will be led by a large group of throwers on both the men's and women's sides.... Eight of the Aggies' 13 NCAA qualifiers will throw the discus, shot put or javelin, starting on Wednesday.... Senior Katy Doyle will lead the way for the women's team in the javelin.... The sixth-year athlete's toss of 179-7 on May 1 ranks second in the nation, making her the highest-ranked Aggie entering the national meet.... Melissa Guilli will end her career at the NCAA championships this week.... The five-time All-American will compete in the 10,000-meter run, where she currently ranks fourth in the country.... Senior Ronny Jimenez and sophomore Fabrice Lapierre will enter the NCAA championship ranked in the national Top 10 in their respective events.... Jimenez is ranked seventh in the nation in the shot put (64-1 3/4), while Lapierre is fifth in the long jump (26-0 3/4).

TEXAS TECH

Amidst a field of 41 teams, the Raiders track and field teams made quite a statement with the men's team finishing fifth with 53.35 points and the women's team 11th with 23 points at the Midwest Regional in College Station, Texas.... The team qualified 14 athletes in 11 events for the NCAA National Championships.... Junior Jonathan Johnson sealed his second Midwest Regional Championship title in the 800M with a time of 1:47.8 and brought the men's team from 18th to 10th.... In the men's pole vault, Tech had six athletes competing, the most from one school in the competition.... It was a tough field with four vaulters including redshirt freshman Sage Thames and sophomore Bobby Most clearing 17-7 on first attempts.... With six athletes in at 17-11 Thames cleared on his second attempt, a new personal record, while Most cleared on his final attempt. Thames was named runner-up and Most finished in third, both ahead of Nebraska's Eric Eshbach who is ranked No. 1 in the nation. In the women's 4x400, the team saw the return of sophomore Tori Polk who has been injured much of the season. The squad closed in on Wyoming on the homestretch but would finish in third with a time of 3:34.81, the fourth-best time in school history.

2004 Big 12 Conference Outdoor Track and Field Honors Announced; Gary Pepin of Nebraska and Bev Kearney of Texas Awarded Coach of the Year

DALLAS - The Big 12 track and field coaches have selected their honorees for the 2004 Big 12 Outdoor Track and Field awards the conference announced on Wednesday.

Nebraska head coach Gary Pepin was named Men's Head Coach of the Year, while Bev Kearney of Texas was named Women's Head Coach of the Year. Sprinter Darold Williamson of Baylor was selected as the Male Outdoor Performer of the Year and Texas' sprinter Sanya Richards was named Women's Outdoor Performer of the Year. Andra Manson of Texas was chosen as the Male Outdoor Freshman of the Year and Jessica Eldridge of Oklahoma received the Women Freshman of the Year honor.

Gary Pepin, in his 24th season overall and 21st as a head coach for the men's track team, led the Nebraska men to their fourth outdoor title (1998, 2000, 2002 and 2004), winning the last three titles in the last four years. The native of Pittsburgh, Kan. was selected as the Men's Big 12 Outdoor Track and Field Coach of the Year for the third time since the inception of the conference, and also named the 2004 Big 12 Indoor Track and Field Coach of the Year for both men and women as he led the men to their seventh indoor title and the women to their third. In the Big 12, Pepin has the most coach of the year awards for both indoor and outdoor with 13. He has guided his team to 60 indoor and outdoor titles in 24 seasons dating back to the Big Eight which makes him the all-time winningest track and field coach in the history of the Big 12 Conference and the former Big Eight Conference.

Bev Kearney is now in her 12th year at Texas and has led the women's track and field team to five outdoor conference championships (1997-99, 2003-04). The Longhorns had not won back-to-back conference crowns since the 1997 and 1998 Big 12 meets. Overall, this is Kearney's fifth outdoor track and field coach of the year honor and ninth overall including the indoor season. She is the second coach in the league to have the most coach of the year awards for track behind head coach Gary Pepin of Nebraska. Since the inception of the conference, Kearney's teams have never finished worse than third place at a Big 12 meet and have had at least one individual or relay team take home a Big 12 crown.

Williamson, the 400-meter dash Big 12 champion, was selected as the Male Outdoor Performer of the Year for the first time in his college tenure. The San Antonio, Texas, native won his third straight 400-meter title last weekend at the Big 12 Outdoor Track and Field Championship in Norman, Okla. He beat his previous two times of 45.88 seconds and 45.76 from 2002 and 2003, clocking in at 44.74 seconds, winning in a controversial fashion, with teammate Jeremy Wariner being disqualified after running 44.29 seconds in the event. The junior also anchored the Big 12 champion 4x400 relay team for the third straight year, giving the Bears seven straight titles in the event. The relay team ranks No. 1 in the country with a time of 3:01.06 after capturing the NCAA Indoor championship earlier this year. Williamson still holds the No. 1 time in the world for the 400, at 44.59 seconds and leads the nation, region and Big 12 list with the exact time.

Sprinter Sanya Richards, the Most Valuable Performer at the Big 12 Outdoor meet, has been selected for the second straight time as the female Performer of the Year, after being selected as the 2004 Indoor Performer of the Year. Richards tallied up 25 points to win her second consecutive high point scorer award at a Big 12 Outdoor meet. At the league championships, she won her second straight crown in the 100- and 200-meter dash and was part of the 4x100 and 4x400- meter relay teams who also won back-to-back championships to take their fifth Big 12 trophy home. Currently, the Pembroke Pines, Fla., native, ranks No. 1 in the Big 12 and Mid-West region with

her 22.73 prelim time that she ran at the league meet in the 200-meter and is amongst the Top 20 in the world for the 100-and 200-meter.

Manson, in his debut season took home his second consecutive Big 12 high jump crown. He won his first league title at the Big 12 Indoor Track and Field Championship this past February in Lincoln, Neb. The true freshman cleared 7-3 at the Big 12 Outdoor meet last weekend and assisted the Longhorns to a fourth place finish overall. His clearance of 7-5 at the Penn Relays two weeks ago currently has him as the No. 1 high jumper in the Big 12 and the Mid-West Region, No. 2 on the NCAA list and in the Top 20 on the world list.

Eldridge became the first woman for Oklahoma to take the Freshman of the Year honor, behind DaBryan Blanton who was the first male to receive Freshman of the Year for the Sooners last season. At the Big 12 Outdoor championships, Eldridge took gold in the 800-meter run with a 2:07.62 time last Saturday. Last Friday, the freshman ran a 2:06.86 prelim time to give her a better regional qualification in the event. She currently holds the best 800-meter junior time in the USA at 2:06.33 (Indoor time). She also participated in the 5,000 meter run for the first time at the conference meet and ran a 16:46.08 to give herself a regional qualification in the event. The Broken Arrow, Okla., native currently ranks second in the 800-meter in the Big 12, as well as fifth and 11th in the 1,500 - and 5,000 - meter run.
